#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello GCTC Membership, I am taking this opportunity to address the issue that we are all following: the Coronavirus (COVID-19). It has to be taken seriously by our club, especially with the high percentage of 65+ year-old members. While the problem here is nothing compared to China or Italy, it does have the potential to become that serious without effective measures being taken.

My son, Bernie, is a Deputy Fire Chief for Lakeside District of San Diego. He is the agency's infectious disease control officer. I just spent the week with him, and he assures me COVID-19 does have the potential to be a life altering pandemic in our state. The recent instructions from the Governor's Office (closing pubs and bars, having individuals with health compromises and older than 65, isolating at home) are a thoughtful and effective plan at limiting exposure for at-risk people. Frequent hand washing and social distancing are also important and effective.

With the above on our mind, the GCTC leadership is evaluating how to move forward as a club. This includes possibly postponing club events (Poker Ride, workdays, guided rides, meetings, etc.) until we have a better understanding of the spread and scope of the disease over the next several weeks or possibly even months. We are actively discussing it at this time and will keep membership notified with "GCTC Official Email" alerts.



A New Member Orientation was held after the February board meeting. New members were provided raffles tickets for a random prize drawing.



## IS YOUR TRAILER READY TO ROLL?

Maybe you were able to head out to the trails during our warm February, or maybe your trailer has been sitting all winter—or for a few years. Either way, you need to make sure it's safe for you to tow, your horses (and his friends) to travel in, and for others who share the road.

- If you have mats, pull them up and check for rust and corrosion, and weak spots in the flooring. (It's recommended you pull the mats and rinse down the flooring after every use.)
- Check the undercarriage for rust and corrosion as well.
- Check your tires for wear, replace if needed (no one wants a blowout!).
- Check tire pressure, including your spare tire.
- Check your electric brakes, and brake controller.
- Check all your lights: turn signals, brake and marker lights.
- Check the tightness of your wheel lugs.
- Lubricate your hitch ball and all hinges periodically.
- Check for wasps in any opening inside and out!

Take it to your favorite trailer repair person if you have any concerns.




## BE SAFE, HAVE FUN!
