# Horse Camping and Trail Riding Clinic

**June 21-22, 2008**

## Details:

- Clinic will start at 1pm Saturday June 21 and conclude approx. 4pm Sunday June 22
- Cost is \$220 per horse/rider, includes camping fee
- See directions to the Euer Valley campsite below
- Bring your own food and camping supplies. Check with others who are going to combine meal options
- For your horse, bring a water bucket (there is water on site), hay/feed, flyspray/mask, manure fork, tack/training equipment that you use
- Note: It can be cold at night so it is recommended you bring a blanket for your horse and sufficient bedding for yourself
- You can arrive Friday night, you will be responsible for that nights fee

## Directions:

Take I80 towards Truckee and exit at the Hwy 89N/Sierraville offramp. Continue on Hwy 89N for approx 2.5 miles to the Alder Creek Road turnoff on the left. Follow Alder Creek Road through the Tahoe-Donner subdivision and past the Tahoe-Donner stables until you reach the end of the paved road. Follow the gravel road down into the valley. Do not turn off the gravel road, stay straight on it as it winds down. At the bottom bear right over a low flat metal bridge to the North-South Meadows Campground which will be immediately after you cross the bridge. Select a campsite and corral. You may see Roy who is the camp host, tell him you are with our group. Note: From I80 to the campsite is approx 6 miles.
